Habitat for Humanity East Central Ohio Celebrates Milestone 650th Home While Honoring the Legacy of Habitat Pioneer Bill Clarke

Habitat for Humanity and Hilscher-Clarke Electric Partner to Build Milestone Home with the Frederick Family

Canton, Ohio, September 2, 2024 — Habitat for Humanity East Central Ohio will mark a significant milestone with the dedication of its 650th home on Thursday, September 5, at 11:00 AM. This achievement, representing 36 years of building homes, communities, and hope locally since 1988, will be celebrated with the Frederick family at the newly built home at 909 Prospect Ave SW, Canton, Ohio.

The 650th home, built in partnership with Hilscher-Clarke Electric, carries special significance because of the company's deep-rooted connection to Habitat for Humanity. Bill Clarke, late CEO of Hilscher-Clarke and a founding board member of Habitat for Humanity International, was a dear friend of Millard Fuller, the founder of Habitat for Humanity. Clarke played a pivotal role in establishing the global organization while also championing Habitat's mission locally. His efforts have contributed to providing decent, affordable housing to millions of families worldwide, and in the local community.

During their partnership with Habitat, the Frederick family completed educational courses on home maintenance, financial literacy, and personal development before working alongside volunteers from Hilscher-Clarke to build their new home. Following the celebration, they will purchase the home with an affordable 0% interest mortgage, a key part of how Habitat empowers families to achieve long-term strength and stability through homeownership.

"This 650th home is not just a milestone—it represents 650 families whose lives have been transformed, 650 stories of hope, and countless children who now have a stable foundation for their future," said Beth Lechner, CEO of Habitat for Humanity East Central Ohio. "As we celebrate this accomplishment and continue building to meet the growing need for affordable housing in our community, we are deeply grateful for our friends at Hilscher-Clarke Electric. Their partnership with Habitat continues to light the way toward a brighter future as we build on the empowering legacy of Bill Clarke."
